Asia Pacific Rally Championship Pirelli Star Driver Entry Conditions

OVERVIEW

The Pirelli 'Star Driver' scheme is a worldwide search for five young rally drivers from the 2008 and 2009 FIA Regional Championships. The successful drivers from each year will then contest a series of six World Championship rallies the following season, driving identical Group N or Super 2000 cars supplied and serviced under an FIA contract with a specialist preparation company. The competitors must be under the age of 27 on 1st January in the year of the Regional Championship.

The FIA have allocated £80,000.00 for each of 2 years to assist in developing the championship and more importantly to provide funding to assist in finding a "Star driver" from the region to contest 6 rounds of the WRC Search for a Star project.

This project provides the 1 Driver from the APRC be awarded a "Star Driver" title and contest 6 rounds of the WRC, mainly in Europe in either a Group N or S2000 car. The project will provide and run 5 identical cars in 6 nominated rounds of the WRC. In addition the drivers will be provided with a personal development programme.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- 1) All drivers must be permanent residents of a country from within the Asia or Pacific regions.
- 2) The drivers must be under 27 on the 1st January 2008.
- 3) One event of those qualifying for the Pacific Cup (sub region) be named as the Pacific qualifying event in each of the years 2008 and 2009 and is open to drivers from the Pacific Region Countries.
- 4) One event of those qualifying for the Asia Cup (sub region) be named as the Asia qualifying event in each of the years 2008 and 2009 and is open to drivers from the Asia Region Countries.
- 5) That under 27 year drivers from Countries in the APRC region other than APRC event countries are permitted to enter and qualify for the award but will not be eligible for travel funding.
- 6) Competitors can use any car that qualifies for the APRC.
- 7) A separate category (Pirelli Star) will be maintained in the results.
- 8) Points will be allocated to qualifying drivers on stage places (3 first, 2 second, 1 third,) giving a total at the end of the event which recognises consistent speed.
- 9) The 1st and 2nd placed under 27 yr competitors in the qualifying Pacific event will have financial freight and travel assistance to contest the qualifying Asia event which will in effect become the "Star Driver" Final.
- 10) That the winning driver from the qualifying Asia event be awarded the Star driver title and contest the WRC events as the APRC representative. For promotional purposes a "Star Driver" from each of Asia and Pacific will be named based on points gained at the qualifying Asia event (Only the overall winner goes forward to WRC).
- 11) The APRC Executive reserve the right to review entries seeking funding and to review the winners of the award. The APRC Executive will elect the Star Driver based on the results and other pertinent information. Their decision is FINAL.
- 12) The qualifying events are;
