- 19.1 The Protest fee is set by the MAI as a sum of Rs. 10,000 /-
- 19.2 If the protest requires the dismantling and the re assembly of clearly defined parts of a car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit of Rs.6,000/-
 - 19.2.1 The expenses incurred by the work and for the transport of the car shall be borne by the claimant if the protest is unfounded, or by the competitor against whom the protest is lodged if it is upheld.
- 19.3 If the protest is unfounded, and if the expenses incurred by the protest (Scrutineering, transport, etc.) are higher than the amount of the deposit , the difference shall be borne by the claimant. Conversely, if the expenses are less, the difference shall be returned to them.
- 19.4 The appeal fee is set by the MAI as a sum of Rs. 30,000/-
